For Tutu Gallery's pop-up at GALLERY CUBED, they are presenting the work of Chinese artist Xingze Li. Using spray paint, acrylic, glass, and printed photos, Li's work blurs the lines between reality and illusion, distorting physical distances and spatial relationships. Adding transparent top layers, Li creates smooth surfaces that emphasize mechanical flatness and simplicity. Focusing on the delineation of empty space, and the ways in which light reflects on surfaces, Li evokes a vague sense of the strange and familiar through his abstract images. With an interest in universal human experiences, Li draws on natural and built structures to construct experiences of the phenomenal world.

Xingze Li is a Chinese artist who holds an MFA from New York's Pratt Institute. He has shown his work and curated exhibitions in China and the United States. Recent group exhibitions in New York include shows at the Pratt Institute Gallery, cfcp Gallery, and East Hall Gallery.

ABOUT TUTU GALLERY:

Tutu Gallery is a feline-owned DIY space located in Bed-Stuy, Brooklyn, founded in July 2019 by Tutu (cat) and her human assistant, April Zhu. Tutu is dedicated to under-the-radar talents who are self-trained, still enrolled in school, or of foreign nationalities. We display works that stay true to our shared and ordinary experience of being. The gallery has a sliding scale commission rate of 10-30%, while featuring a range of handmade souvenirs. In addition, we collaborate with our artists in writing exhibition proposals for other organizations, developing price points, and seeking press coverage.
